MEDICAL AID IN DYING**

WHEREAS, Unitarian Universalists affirm the inherent worth and dignity of every person and the right of individuals to make decisions about their own bodies and their own lives;

WHEREAS, our tradition upholds compassion, autonomy, and the alleviation of suffering as core moral commitments;


WHEREAS, many people facing terminal illness or irreversible decline seek the option of Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID) as a means of exercising agency and reducing unnecessary suffering at the end of life;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Unitarian Universalist Fellowship of Raleigh supports the legal, ethical, and compassionate availability of Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this congregation affirms the right of individuals—within appropriate medical and legal safeguards—to choose MAID as an expression of personal dignity, self-determination, and freedom from undue suffering;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this congregation encourages continued public education, thoughtful dialogue, and advocacy consistent with these values.
